## Textual summaries for the root of the context tree:

- Cupid is trying to make a couple get together.
- (1) Cupid misses Bill and Tina. He hits Tommy, who falls in love with himself. (2) Tommy is not affected by Cupid's arrows and this causes Lauryn to make a mistake
- Cupid successfully targets Bill and Tina with arrows making them fall in love, but fails with Tommy and Rachel since he was distracted by a butterfly.
- Cupid shoots Bill and Tina and makes them fall in love but accidentally shot Tommy twice where he then falls in love with himself.



## Shot descriptions:

0	Rachel is walking passed a sign that changes to show the credits.	
1	Cupid sit on a roof, sipping a drink.	
2	Cupid sits on a roof drinking coffee as a scroll floats down and bonks him on his head.	
3	Cupid sits on a rooftop drinking coffee while his scroll floats towards them. He then sees an image depicting Bill and Tina, with a heart stamped in between them	
4	Cupid lets the Scroll float away.	
5	From the top of a roof, Cupid flies away.	
6	Cupid flies down above Tina who is sitting outside reading a newspaper	

7	Cupid floats above Bill and Tina, while aiming his arrow towards them	
8	Cupid shoots an arrow at both Bill and Tina in front of a cafe. Tina and Bill turn around and exchange smiles	
9	Cupid glances down at Bill and Tina, while they turn around to look at each other at the outdoor cafe.

11	Cupid is hovering in the air above a building when a glowing scroll floats down from above him. He grabs the scroll, unravels it, and begins reading it.

14	Tommy is sitting on a bench looking at his phone when Cupid strikes him with an arrow. He looks in lust as Rachel walks by.	
15	Cupid prepares his bow and arrow, when he is distracted by a beautiful blue butterfly.

17	Tommy sits on a bench in a haze, Cupid adjusts his focus to Rachel.	

18	Cupid tries to make Tommy look at Rachel, but Tommy instead sees his own reflection.	
19	Cupid shoots Tommy with love arrows. Tommy falls in love with himself	
20	Tommy watches his reflection adoringly as cupid unsuccessfully attempts to remove the arrow from his back	
21	Cupid accidentally shoots Tommy with two arrows instead of one and Rachel with the other.	
22	Tommy sprays himself with perfume as Rachel walks by. Cupid reacts in frustration.	
23	Cupid chases after Tommy	
24	Cupid flies down the street after Tommy to retrieve his arrows out of Tommy's back.	
25	Tommy is running around a street with Cupid hanging on to the arrows in Tommy's back. Tommy stops to check his reflection out in a window.	
26	Tommy see's himself in the mirror.	
27	Tommy is dancing on stage as some tango music plays.	
28	Cupid is watching Tommy dance. He has two arrows in his back.	
29	Rachel begins to walk by in the background as the unknown man Salsa dances. Cupid sees her and tries to push the unknown man to dance with her.	

30	Rachel walks by as Tommy spins in love.	
31	Rachael walks down the street past rows of houses as music plays. Tommy runs by her with Cupid on his shoulders.	
32	Tommy chases after a piece of paper as Cupid rides his back. Cupid sticks an arrow with him and then Tommy jumps off a ramp.	
33	Tommy is falling through the air, with arrows in his back and looking at himself in the mirror. Once he reaches the ground, he sees Cupid	
34	An upside down Tommy sees Cupid as Rachel walks on some crazy ramp.	
35	Tommy is walking on a path, and Cupid is chasing after him, pulling on the arrows in Tommy's back.	
36	Tommy is running along a path, and Cupid is being carried along behind him.	
37	Cupid seems frustrated as there is some crazy lights around him.	
38	Cupid tries to reach Tommy but he can't as Tommy runs up steps.	
39	Cupid tries to reach Rachel but can't.	
40	Cupid is looking up the staircases and follows a person into a magic mirror.	
41	Tommy is about to jump off of a building.	
42	Cupid saves Tommy from jumping off the bridge. By doing this he pulls one of the arrows out of Tommy's back.	
43	Cupid is about to hit someone with an arrow, and he's looking around to see who walks by	
44	Lauryn walks sadly past Cupid. Cupid is about to hit Lauryn with the arrow!	
45	Cupid shoots Lauryn with an arrow. Lauryn immediately stops walking and stares straight ahead. Cupid seems pleased with himself as he stands beside the scroll, but then realizes that nothing will happen as the camera pans up to show both Lauryn and a previously shot Bob(?) are not	

	looking at each other.	
46	Scroll appears by Cupid, resulting him to pull out his quill and secretly begin writing in it.	
47	Cupid writes down in his scroll with a feathered pen	
48	Cupid glances at a picture of Tommy and Lauryn.	
49	Cupid has shot Lauryn and Tommy who are walking away from each other on a quiet Parisian street. The arrows begin to do their work and the pair are about to turn to face one another. Cupid checks his scroll and celebrates another match made.	
50	Cupid is dancing because Tommy and Lauryn seem to like each other. There's a clap of thunder and a Scroll appears.	
51	Cupid looks at his scroll with depicts Lauryn with someone who is not Tommy

## Evaluations

### Full movie summaries: (avg. len 102)

- After doing mundane task after task like making Bill and Tina fall in love, Cupid becomes bored and easily distracted with his job. As hes assigned to bring Tommy and Rachel together he becomes distracted and misfires hitting Tommy twice. Tommy then falls in love with himself forcing Cupid on a wild chase to correct his mistake. Even though when Cupid believes hes solved the problem by

making Lauryn fall for Tommy he instead receives a new assignment forcing him to start a new chase all over again as Lauryn is meant to be with Bob. (96)

- Cupid sits on his roof when a floating scroll comes up to him. He grabs it and reads and sees two old people on it. He then flies off to find them, and shoots an arrow at the old man (Bill) and the old lady (Tina). Then Cupid flies off. He accidentally shoots Tommy twice with arrows. He falls in love with his own reflection. Chaos ensues while Cupid works to take out the arrow from his back and shoot it at someone else, like Rachel or Lauryn later causing even more issues. (92)
- Cupid is having breakfast and is interrupted by a message from above that he must use his arrows to make two people fall in love. He finishes his breakfast and heads out to find the people. He finds them in a cafe. He shoots one and then the other and the two turn to find each other and fall in love. Cupid gets another message to bring two other people together. He shoots one arrow at the guy but becomes distracted and he shoots the guy again. The guy sees his image in a store window and falls in love with himself. The rest of the story is Cupid trying to right what he did wrong. He finally does and brings the guy together with a different girl. However he gets another message from above with the girl he just coupled with another guy. (144)
- Cupid was on the rooftop drinking a cup of coffee. He saw a floating scroll and decided to open it. He saw Bob and Tina on the scroll. He shot a love arrow at them. He saw Tommy and decided to shoot a love arrow at him. By accident, he shot another love arrow at Tommy. He had meant to shoot an arrow at Rachel. He chased around Tommy for miles trying to pull out the arrow. (77)
- Cupid successfully brings together Bill and Tina. His next scroll-assignment tells him to shoot his arrows into Tommy and Rachel. By accident Tommy gets shot twice and falls in love with himself. Cupid gets the second arrow out of Tommy and saves his life. Cupid shoots the second arrow at Lauryn making Tommy and Lauryn fall in love. Cupid understands later that he made another mistake, because Lauryn is supposed to fall in love with Bob. (76)

## Causality summaries: (avg. len 105)

- Cupid is sitting on a roof, relaxing. Suddenly a scroll flights down to him, which he doesn't want. He seems bored with those tasks. But the scrolls keep coming and he decided to act upon this last one. \r\nWhen trying to finish his job, he shoots Tommy twice and he falls in love with himself. \r\nCupid tries to pull the second arrow without success. Tommy becomes very in-tune with himself. \r\n\r\nSecond act we see cupid still trying to pull the arrow from Tommy, but Tommy seems more and more in love with himself to the point of almost killing

himself. \r\nFinally cupid is able to pull the arrow out and shoots Lauryn, who was not the intended target for Tommy.\r\n\r\nIn the end, cupid get a new scroll instructing him to pair Lauryn with Bob. (145)

- In the city of love (Paris), Cupid is distracted in his work and accidentally makes Tommy narcissistically fall in love with himself. Cupid struggles to get Tommy to fall in love with Rachel. Failing that, Cupid gets Tommy to fall in love with Lauryn instead. Unfortunately, Lauryn belongs with Bob, we learn! (52)
- While cupid is sitting and sipping a cup of coffee, he gets hit by a magical scroll, but Cupid ignores the scroll and flies away, but the magical scroll follows him and bumps him again. He (Cupid) reads the scroll and decides to shoot Tommy with the arrow of love, he hits him, and next target is Rachel, but he gets distracted by a butterfly and hits Tommy again. Cupid tries to find another arrow to fix the error, by chasing a guy who he have shot twice. Ultimately he gets the arrow, but saddened that the person who he gets the arrow off isn't happy as it is, he shoots a passing girl, who happens to be Lauryn with the arrow. They seem happy, but Cupid another scroll bumps into him, revealing that the girl he just shot, who is Lauryn, with the love arrow is destined to be with another guy named Bob. (155)
- Cupid is sitting on a roof when a scroll comes down to him. Frustrated and sad he pushes the scroll away. Seeing Tommy sitting on a bench he shoots him with an arrow but gets distracted by a butterfly. Tommy then falls in love with himself instead of the the female walking by because he saw himself in the mirror. Cupid tries to take the arrow out of his back but fails. Cupid then continues to try to get Tommy to fall in love with Rachel but fails. Cupid finally gets the arrow out of his back and shoots Lauryn with an arrow and they fall in love. (108)
- Cupid makes a mistake while trying to hook up Tommy and Rachel causing Tommy to fall in love with himself, after a lot of trying he is able to stop Tommy from being in love with himself, but by that time Rachel is gone, so he makes him fall in love with Lauryn, only to find out that she was meant to fall in love with Bob. (67)
