

Accessing “Don’t Make Me Think” by Steve Krug in the Safari Tech Books collection:

- 1) Go to this page in the library database portal
<http://furbo.gmu.edu/dbwiz/alpha.php?start=s>
- 2) Click on “Safari Tech Books Online.” It is the second link at the top of the list. If you are off-campus, you will be prompted to log-in using your Mason email username and password.
- 3) The next page that opens will be the Safari home page. Search the ISBN number in the search box at the top: **0321344758 – 2006 edition**
0789723107 - 2000 edition
- 4) If searched by ISBN, the next page will be the home page for the book. Access the book through the “Table of Contents” link or through the “Start Reading” link.
- 5) Book HTML View:
